

More than <u>1 in 5</u> women seeking care following abuse have reported living with at least one type of disability.

Abuse can include:

- Physical assault
- Any unwanted sexual act
- Verbal threats/abuse
- Emotional/Psychological abuse
- Neglect
- Financial/Material abuse
- Withholding access to information, medical equipment, communication devices, or medications
- Forced isolation from others
- Decision-making on behalf of the woman without her consent
